Dear Parents/Carers

It hardly seems possible that we have been back at school for three weeks! The children have settled well into the routines of their new classes.

Thank you for signing up for consultation meetings; confirmation of times will be sent next week. The focus of this meeting is to discuss how your child has settled into his/her new class. We allocate 10 minutes for each appointment; if you feel you have an issue to discuss that will require longer than this please can I ask you to make a separate appointment at another time.

Activities Grant

We have received new funding to help identified children take part in a range of school activities such as after-school clubs and school visits at a reduced cost.

In order to qualify we need to know if families are:

- a) eligible for free school meals or
b) receiving any of the following:
- Housing Benefit
 - Disability Working Allowance
 - Council Tax Benefit
 - Income Support
 - Job seeker's allowance
 - Working tax credit
 - Pension Credit

If your child is already entitled to free school meals, you do not need to do anything further.

If you feel that you may qualify due to a) or b) above please contact the head teacher at the school office. All applications must be received by 30th September and will be treated in the strictest of confidence.

We hope that all eligible parents will take up this opportunity for their children. If you have any queries, do not hesitate to contact me.
