

## **Classroom Visits (Class 1 – June 28th & July 7th OR Class 2 – June 30th & July 5th)**

Each child will be invited to spend two sessions in school (1.45 - 3.00). During the first visit a member of staff from Milton Cygnets will also be in the classroom so most children will recognise a familiar face. **Children will not be allocated to either Foundation class until later when more accurate numbers are known.**

### ***Parents Information Evening***

All parents are invited to a meeting on **July 12th (6.00- 8.00pm)**. Between 6.00 – 7.00 they will have the opportunity to purchase school uniform, visit the classrooms and meet the teachers. At 7.00 we will hold a more formal session to talk about the Foundation Curriculum and share information about school routines.

### **Admissions Procedure**

The school term starts on Tuesday 6th September. In order to ensure that each child is welcomed into school and given individual attention admissions will be staggered over the first week.

**Morning (9.00-12.00noon) – Spring & Summer born children** (birth dates 01/01/07-31/08/07) only.  
**Afternoon (1.30 – 3.15pm) – Autumn born children** (birth dates 01/09/06 - 31/12/06) only.
- **Thursday**  
**Morning (9.00-12.00noon) – Autumn born children** (birth dates 01/09/06 - 31/12/06) only.  
**Afternoon (1.30 – 3.15pm) – Spring & Summer born children** (birth dates 01/01/07-31/08/07) only.
- **Friday**  
**Morning (9.00-12.00noon) – all children**  
**Afternoon – no children**

## **Week Two**

- **Autumn born children** (birth dates 01/09/06 - 30/12/06) start full time schooling. (8.55-3.15pm.)
- **Spring and summer born children remain attending on a part time basis. (8.55-12.00)**
- **Wednesday- Class 1 parents** are invited to have a school lunch with their child  
(Sorry we cannot accommodate pre school children at the meal)
- **Thursday- Class 2 parents** are invited to have a school lunch with their child.  
(Sorry we cannot accommodate pre school children at the meal)
  
- **Friday- short consultations will be offered to parents who feel that their part time child is ready for full time school (12- 1.00 & 2.0 - 4.30).**

***I would like to stress that there will be no pressure for spring and summer born children to attend full time before they are ready.***
