Dear Parent

I would like to invite you to join the 200 Club for the school year 2011/2012. The 200 Club has raised in the region of £5000 for school funds since it was formed. Shares of £5 each are sold with no limit to the number of shares you can buy, although each share must be held in a single name. Half the cost of each share goes to the school with the other half being returned in prize money throughout the year. Depending on the number of shares sold, we hope to give out at least two to three £10 prizes each month, with the balance being given out at the annual summer barbecue.

Needless to say the more shares sold the greater the number of prizes that are given.

Simply fill in the slip below and return it to school with your payment (preferably a cheque payable to the MSA), in an envelope marked 200 Club. Please return by Friday 30th September. You will be issued with a share certificate, with your lucky number(s) for the year.

We have included the Gift Aid Declaration form. PLEASE, if you are a tax payer, can you complete this form. This means that where money is paid under gift aid we can reclaim basic rate tax at 20% of the gross amount received. However note that whoever signs the gift aid declaration should also sign the cheque as the taxpayer.

Please note that if you complete a gift aid declaration for the MSA, and take part in the 200 Club, then the MSA will claim half your 200 Club payment as a donation for gift aid purposes.
