

Napp Science Visit 2!

We had more visitors from Napp Science today (they must like our school!) and this time they came to talk to us about the science of ice-cream. We actually made ice-cream in the classroom in just five minutes, it was amazing!

First of all we had to put four handfuls of ice-cubes in the big bag and add four teaspoons of salt to it.



In the little bag we had to put half a cup full of milk and one teaspoon of milkshake powder and then make sure the bag was sealed shut (and also that there was no salt in it, otherwise it would never turn solid!).
