

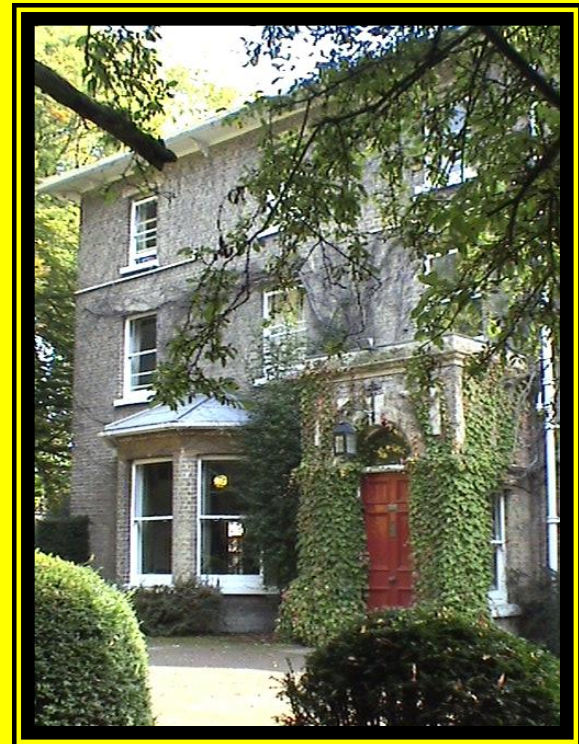

## Year 5 Residential Visit

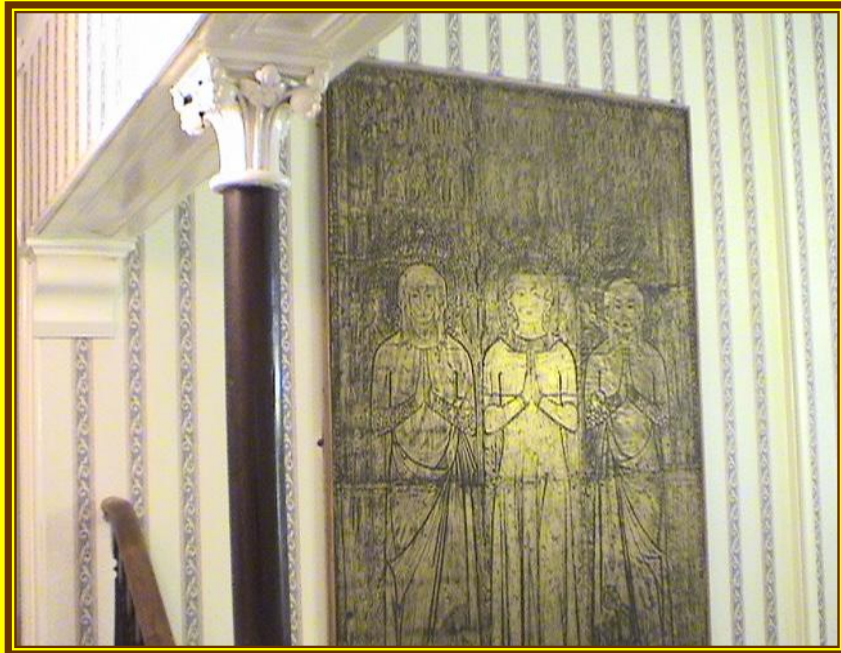


# Objectives

# MEDICAL ISSUES

## ILLNESS

If your child is taken ill during their stay, it may be necessary for us to contact you, so that you can come and collect them.

## MEDICATION

If your child is on medication, it needs to be placed in a bag, clearly labelled with name and instructions, and handed to their class teacher.



## INHALERS

Please make sure that your child knows how to use their inhaler effectively if they are asthmatic.

# General Information



## CAMERAS

Children may bring a camera if they wish, but it is their responsibility. Disposable/digital cameras allowed. Teachers bring cameras to take photos while children taking part in activities. Cameras are not allowed in the dorms.
